Preamble

Statement

The institute is located in an area where green cover is easily maintainable. Greenery is cultivated around the campus with a variety of tree and plant species. Many of the plants are of medicinal values. Regular pruning and trimming are done to maintain the greenery, overseen by a designated gardener and the college beautification committee.

Behind the college building, a large area is kept in its natural state, with trees providing green coverage to the open land. The college also provides an optional paper on 'Gardening' for second year B.Ed. students. Under this optional course students make a kitchen garden in college campus itself.

Every year plantation drives are carried out to increase green cover. These species of plants and trees enable the student teachers of better understanding of important botanical concepts and innovative teaching approaches. When the garden is on full bloom, it creates a serene and picturesque view, the sense of mental bliss.
